Demonstration Kitchen & Group Activity Room

Unavailable

The 1,800 square foot demonstration kitchen and group activity room is a focal point of our learning space and provides the community with access to a variety of educational programs, as well as panoramic views of downtown Lewiston-Auburn. The room can be utilized as one large space for events or divided into two rooms using a retractable wall, lending itself to a myriad of educational workshops, support groups, art and music therapy, volunteer groups and other programs. In the state-of-the-art Demo Kitchen, participants learn the benefits of healthy eating, particularly for cancer prevention, as well as prepare meals themselves. This learning space includes the latest in audio/visual technology, allowing us to broaden our reach and increase our impact on the cancer community through interactive and distance learning.

Healing Garden

The Healing Garden is a meditative and healing space for anyone seeking solitude and serenity. Handcrafted planters, made from reclaimed pine from the historical Bates Mill, house an array of plants and are surrounded by a mural depicting the serenity of a mountain lake. The reflection from the 'birches and vines', along with the sounds of nature introduce visitors to the calming nature of the space. The large windows in the Healing Garden overlook the skyline of Lewiston-Auburn with views of the Androscoggin River. The focal point of the "Garden" is a tribute area for remembering and honoring loved ones impacted by cancer.

Art Gallery & Consult Room

The Art Gallery & Consult room is a cozy, comfortable and private space for cancer-related support and bereavement groups, individual consultations with a financial counselor, registered dietitian or social worker. Unique to this room is the revolving art display depicting various art forms from local artists as well as cancer survivors.
